Stickman

"Stickman" is a performance featuring a man, a stick and a television.

The man holds the stick in balance on various parts of his body, thus setting himself and the stick in motion. Balance is a state of motion, achieved through the negotiation of opposing forces. It usually goes unnoticed until it is disrupted, at which point it becomes extremely significant.

Balance is not only a physical state, but also a metaphor for the constant fluctuation between opposing states, such as life and death, stability and instability. In this performance, balance is used as a way to compel the body into a state of constant motion.

Once a living plant, a stick has now been transformed into a lifeless object, crafted for a specific purpose. However, every object has a story and the stick is no exception. An intimate and surprising artistic encounter that challenges the audience's perception and prompts reflections on the freedom of action.
